

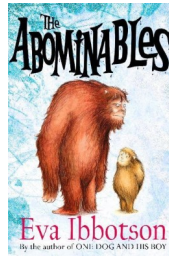
English: The Abominables

Read a range of texts, including narrative, non-fiction and poetry.

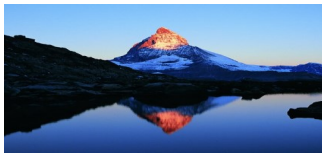


Mathematics
