

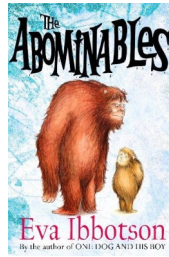

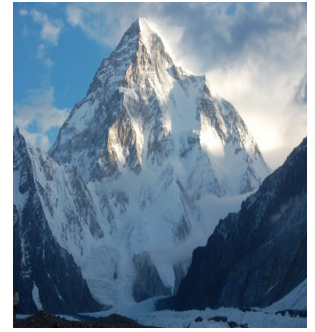

Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed.

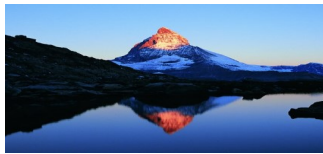
Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
