What is bullying?

It is when a child is getting targeted deliberately and repeatedly by an individual or group.

Bullying doesn't happen in our school because small problems are dealt with immediately. However, if you have a friendship problem, you can be assured that adults will treat your worries seriously and that you will be supported in several ways:

- Everyone involved is listened to
- Strategies for solving any problems are discussed
- Any negative behaviour is recorded
- Adults and children keep an eye on you
- More serious incidents are investigated by the teacher and they tell the Headteacher
- Time is taken to explain why the actions were wrong and how to make the right choices
- If needed, parents and carers are brought into the school to talk about it.
