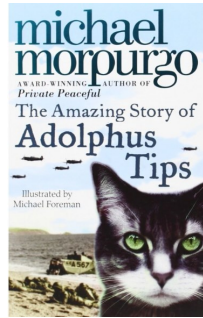


English: The Amazing Adventures of Adolphus Tips

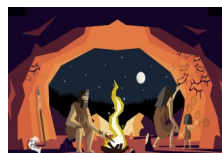
