Re: Report collection

Dear Parents/Carers,

Your child's report is almost ready for collection. Teachers have written reports following the guidance from the Department for Education, which includes details about your child's attainment and progress this academic year up until school closures happened due to Covid-19. We do not have to report on learning during lockdown. Following the cancellation of national curriculum tests (SATs, phonics screening and multiplication tests) this year due to the pandemic, it is not possible to include the outcomes in reports; however, year 6 have been provided with predicted grades to give an indication of what secondary schools have been provided with ahead of next year.

Teacher assessments have taken into consideration the amount of learning children have been able to receive in school this year and attainment/progress measures have been amended accordingly. It is explained further in your child's report but if you have any questions at all or would like to discuss things further, please dojo your child's current class teacher, who can arrange a phone call if you wish.

We have included attendance certificates reporting on your child's attendance up to the school closures for Covid-19 (percentages do not include time during lockdown as it is not compulsory up until the summer holidays to attend during this time and it is also reliant on school capacity to welcome your child back – we know that there are lots of children who would like to come back but are unable to do so).

As you would expect, we will need to organise staggered collection dates and times to ensure we fully adhere to social distancing and meet the requirements of our school risk assessment.

We will organise an outside collection point where you will be able to collect your child's report and any other personal items that were left in school when school closed (P.E. kits, homework projects, books, things left in drawers etc.).

In order to avoid too many people being on site at once, we ask that only one adult attends per family (unless arrangements have been made with our school office in advance) and that if you require another person (not the child's parents) to collect the report and items, please notify us in advance via text so that we have written permission to hand these things over.

There will be further opportunities to come and collect your child's report and other items if you are unable to make the dates/times below. We will send these out at a later date. If you have more than one child in school and wish to attend once only, please come to the later date to ensure the report is ready. If your child is attending school, reports will be available on drop off for you.





Please follow our one way system marked on the carpark in yellow spray paint and use the markings to adhere to 2 metre social distancing.
