<i>City</i>	<i>A city is a large place where people live.</i>
<i>Country</i>	<i>A big area including many cities. All countries have a government.</i>
<i>United Kingdom</i> <i>UK</i>	<i>England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales are all the countries that make the United Kingdom.</i>
<i>Island</i>	<i>A piece of land surrounded by water.</i>
<i>Human features</i>	<i>Things humans have made, e.g. houses.</i>
<i>Physical features</i>	<i>Things that are natural, e.g. trees.</i>
<i>Deciduous trees</i>	<i>Deciduous means 'fall off'. These trees lose their leaves in Autumn.</i>
<i>Evergreen trees</i>	<i>These trees keep their leaves all year. They are always green.</i>
<i>Past</i>	<i>Something from before.</i>
<i>Present</i>	<i>Right now.</i>

## What should I know by the end of the topic?


- Bristol is a city and London is the capital city of England.
