### Class Zoom Sessions

Dear Parents / Carers,

As suggested in yesterday's text message, this letter will be providing further information regarding the final Zoom class session next week before all the children return to school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

Firstly, I want to point out a slight change. Whereas the date in the text message suggested it will go ahead on Wednesday or Thursday next week, **the final Zoom session will be on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March**. Therefore, in line with the same date provided in the recent World Book Day letter.

The access codes for the sessions will be sent out via text message on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2021. The date and timings of the sessions can be viewed below:

Year 1 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March from 10am – 10:20pm  
Year 2 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March from 1pm – 1:20pm  
Year 3 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March from 9:35am – 9:55am  
Year 4 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March from 1:30pm – 1:50pm  
Year 5 – Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> March from 2:30pm – 2:50pm  
Year 6 – Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March from 11:30am – 12pm

Before participating in the Zoom session, I would just like to re-emphasise a couple of points to ensure the smooth running of the sessions.

- 1) We are asking for all children's devices to be on silent unless they are talking directly to the teacher. Therefore, could you support your child to silence their device throughout the session unless they are communicating with the class and the class teacher.
- 2) Whilst the session is taking place on Zoom, can adults who are in close proximity to the device being used for the session refrain from having conversations with others.
- 3) Once again, can we ask for everyone to start signing into the meeting five minutes earlier than the start of the session.





**We will be taking the previous parents' permissions for their children to participate in the Zoom sessions as authorisation for their children to participate again this week, unless we are notified via the school office.**

Thank you once again for all of your support and we are looking forward to next week's Zoom sessions with the children before welcoming everyone back into school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021. On that note, a letter with all the information regarding the re-opening of the school will be sent out to parents on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021.
