Dear Parents / Carers,

As we head into the second half of the Curriculum Unit focused on answering the over-arching question of 'Who left Britain with the greatest legacy – The Romans, Vikings or Saxons?', we wanted to explore the possibility of a virtual visitor being able to explore the question further with the children.

On that note, we have booked Amie Friend from 'The Time Seekers' who will conduct a virtual session with each class on Tuesday 27th April 2021. The Year 4 session will be at 11am and the Year 3 session will be at 1pm.

Within the session, Amie will be exploring when the Romans arrived in Britain and what effect they had on us as an island. She is also going to be looking at when the Vikings arrived in Britain and how Britain changed because of their arrival. Amie is an archaeologist so throughout the session will be sharing a range of different artefacts with the children as well.
