The past year has been a challenging time for us all, and for Lifeskills, the knock-on effect has been a decline in our volunteer numbers. As a result, we've had to reduce the number of children/schools we can accommodate in 2021/2022 by 50%, which, going forward, is unsustainable for the charity.

Although we'll continue to offer our safety video subscription to those schools on our waiting list, we're devastated that over 6,000 Year 6 children might miss out on the hands-on, memorable experience, that we enjoy providing.
