Re: Y6 Leavers' service 1.30pm Monday 19th July

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to remind you that the Year 6 leavers' service will be taking place on Monday 19th July at 1.30pm. As you will be aware from previous communications, despite the restrictions being lifted next week, as a school and in line with local authority advice, we will be keeping our full risk assessment in place. We are still able to go ahead with the leavers' service but it will be outside and we would appreciate it if all parents/carers could support us with the below considerations.

The service will be conducted outside on the school playground and following the service, for those who have ordered, a picnic will be provided to be eaten on the school field.

Things to consider:

We will require you to complete a track and trace form and sign to say you haven't got any of the symptoms of Covid-19.

We also ask that anyone coming onto school premises for the service takes a Lateral Flow test before coming (as advised by the South Glos Education Department and Public Health).

Parents will be required to social distance and we will group families into 4 groups and ask that you remain in those groups during the picnic.

Only parents/carers, who have notified us of their attendance, will be able to attend as we have organised seating in line with our risk assessment.

As it is outside, we are weather dependent so please consider bringing something warm to pop on if the weather turns.

You may want to bring a blanket to sit on for the picnic.

Please make sure your child has sunscreen and a hat.

We know that not all parents/carers are staying for the picnic. Children may leave with their parents/carers only after the Leavers' service if you wish. We will, however, be here until the end of the school day if you would like your child to stay. Please note that you are more than welcome to stay and sit with your child and their group, while they have their picnic, even if you don't wish to eat yourself.

We are looking forward to seeing you all on Monday to celebrate your child's time at primary school and thank you in advance for helping the community to stay safe.
