Key Vocabulary

<i>City</i>	A city is a large place where people live.
<i>Country</i>	A big area including many cities. All countries have a government.
<i>United Kingdom</i> <i>UK</i>	England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales are all the countries that make the United Kingdom.
<i>Island</i>	A piece of land surrounded by water.
<i>Human features</i>	Things humans have made, e.g. houses.
<i>Physical features</i>	Things that are natural, e.g. trees.
<i>Deciduous trees</i>	Deciduous means 'fall off'. These trees lose their leaves in Autumn.
<i>Evergreen trees</i>	These trees keep their leaves all year. They are always green.
<i>Past</i>	Something from before.
<i>Present</i>	Right now.

What should I know by the end of the topic?

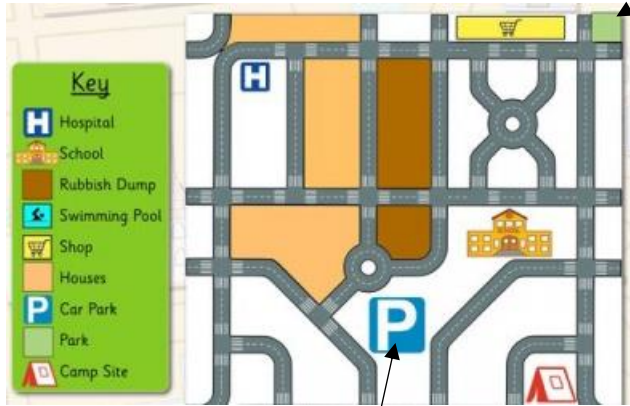
- Bristol is a city and London is the capital city of England.
