Year 3 and 4 Trip to Bristol Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of this term's curriculum topic, the children in year 3 and 4 are learning all about Ancient Egypt. In order to enrich the children's learning, we are thrilled to be visiting the Bristol Museum and Art Gallery to learn more about this period of history on **Tuesday 1st March**.

During the visit, the children will have the opportunity to partake in a workshop gaining knowledge about a local Egyptian archaeologist and handling real and replica artefacts to learn new and memorable knowledge. They will also be exploring the Egyptian exhibition as well as the other exhibitions in the museum.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9.30am and will be returning by 3.00pm. Your child will therefore need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. We would also ask that your child wear their school uniform and comfortable shoes for the day.

Due to the ongoing pandemic, the museum have limited the amount of visitors and children will be divided into small adult-led groups to move around the museum. All adults will need to wear a mask. As you know, there are a number of cases of COVID in the school presently. Just to make you aware that if cases increase in year 3 and 4, nearer the time of the visit, we will need to cancel the trip and try to rearrange.

The cost of the trip is £7.60 per pupil, which includes the cost of the workshop, coach and a small ParentPay fee. The FRIENDS have generously given £200 towards the overall cost, which has been deducted from the total. We would ask for a voluntary contribution in order to cover this cost. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient funds, we may need to cancel the trip. To make a contribution, please pay through www.parentpay.com. Also in order to give consent for your child to attend, please tick the consent box on the parent pay website. Please confirm attendance and payment by Friday 18th February. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, please contact the office as we may be able to support with payment for this trip.

If you are a regular volunteer at school with a DBS and are able to help with this trip, please contact us via dojo. Your help would be much appreciated.
