Dear Parents and Carers,

Throughout this academic year, there has been a limited uptake of children participating in the after-school clubs run by staff members, and in some instances clubs have had to be cancelled. As a school, we want to provide as many different opportunities for all children to learn something new and enjoy participating with other children from across the school.

Therefore, in Term 5, staff will be running lunchtime club opportunities for all children across the school from Reception up to Year 6. The clubs listed below will start week commencing **Monday 25th April 2022**. All children will be able to attend the clubs and there is no need to sign your child up beforehand. The timetables will be available for children to see in their classroom. However, it might be that you discuss with your child which clubs they might want to attend.

Brief overview of each club

Mindfulness Club

An opportunity for children to learn and complete a range of different activities including the following:

- Yoga
- Colouring
- Art

Cartoon Club

Children escape into the world of cartoons. Different cartoons will be playing within the classroom, whilst children also have the opportunity to:

- Develop their artistic interpretations of different cartoons
- Create their own cartoon scripts using stop motion animation

Reading Club

Does your child enjoy reading with their friends? This is a chance for your child to have a read of a vast array of different books from fiction to non-fiction, whilst sitting with their friends.

Computing Club

An opportunity for your child to further develop their computing skills. Within the club, children will have opportunities to access the following:

- TT Rockstars
- Numbots
- Coding through Scratch and Jr Scratch

Puzzle Club

An opportunity to play a range of different types of puzzles with your friends and other children across the school. The types of activities on offer include:

- Sudoku
- Wordsearches
- Crosswords
- Colour by number

Athletics

A chance to get on the field and participate in a range of different types of athletic events including:

- Sprinting
- Long distance running
- Hurdles
- Javelin throwing



When would my child eat their lunch?

The lunchtime clubs will run from 12pm – 1pm. All children will eat their lunch at the normal time and attend the club at times that they aren't eating their lunch. See the table below for more details:
