With the Queen's Platinum Jubilee fast approaching, I wanted to write to you to inform you of how the school plans to celebrate this historic date with the children.

#### Queen's Platinum Jubilee Art Competition

In the next couple of weeks, children across the school will be participating in an art competition during school time, which is being run by John Lewis & Partners, Cribbs Causeway. Children are being asked to draw, paint or collage an A4 picture of The Queen. All artwork, which is entered into the competition, will be displayed in 'The Place to Eat'.

If **you do not give permission** for your child's picture to be entered into the competition, or for your child's work to be photographed and reproduced by John Lewis & Partners, Cribbs Causeway, for the purposes of promoting the art exhibition including; social media, press and publicity, **please get in touch with your child's class teacher via Class Dojo by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> May**. #### Celebratory Learning

On Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May, children will be learning all about the Queen and the Platinum Jubilee. Throughout the day, children will be completing a range of fantastic activities, whilst developing answers to the following key questions:

EYFS – Who is our Queen?

Yr 1 & 2 – What is in the Queen's family and what is her role?

Yr 3 & 4 – What is a Jubilee?

Yr 5 & 6 – How has the commonwealth changed over time?

Children will come together in the afternoon for a special assembly in which they will present their work that they have completed throughout the day, whilst also performing two Jubilee songs that they have been learning this term.

On **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May**, we are inviting parents / carers in to school between **3:30pm and 4pm** to have a look at the children's fantastic artwork, and learning that has been completed throughout the day. If you have time to pop in to the school building, we would love to see you!

#### Jubilee Picnic

Finally, on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May, a Jubilee picnic is being arranged by South Glos Integra, on behalf of our school kitchen. - Entrants are asked to create a piece of **A4 artwork** in any medium, provided it is original artwork (no computer-generated images please) Each entry should be the work of one entrant only.
- Please do not post your artwork to us. We are only accepting entries in person to the Experience Desk. We are unable to return any artwork sent in for the competition.
- We aim to inform all winners within two weeks of the closing date of **Friday 3 June 2022**.
- All entries must be clearly labelled with your name, age, & school on the back of the artwork. Please ask permission from a parent or guardian before entering.
- No cash prize will be given. There will be one winner per age group, who will be notified by John Lewis & Partners, Cribbs Causeway via their school, who will receive a John Lewis & Partners **£50 Gift voucher**. **A donation of £250 will be made to each of the winner's Primary Schools**, to be spent on art and craft materials, or items at their discretion.

- **Competition is open to children of age groups 4 to 7 & 8 to 11**.
