**Costume list:**

**Beast/prince-** Blue suit, horns

**Belle** – Yellow dress, blue dress, white apron, bow for hair

**Gaston** – Bright shirt and trousers

**Lefou** - Bright shirt and trousers

**Madame de la Grande Bouche-** Colourful dress and wardrobe outfit (perhaps dress with buttons down the front, padded sides?)

**Maurice** – Trousers and shirt

**Old beggar woman/ Enchantress** – Sparkly dress and dark cloak

**Cogsworth** – Brown outfit

**Lumiere-** Golden/orange outfit

**Mrs Potts** – Pastel colour dress with padded skirt

**Babette** – Black and white dress or top and skirt, black bow for hair

**Chip** – Pastel coloured outfit

**Narrators and Singing Narrators** – Bright sparkly outfit

**Flatware-** Golden outfit

**Les Filles-** Bright outfit, dress or skirt and top if possible

**Monsieur D'Arque** – Shirt, tie and trousers

**Named villagers and villagers** – colourful top and trousers, aprons if possible

**Wolves** Grey outfit, tail and mask
