Beast/prince- Blue suit, horns

Belle - Yellow dress, blue dress, white apron, bow for hair

**Gaston** – Bright shirt and trousers

**Lefou -** Bright shirt and trousers

**Madame de la Grande Bouche-** Colourful dress and wardrobe outfit (perhaps dress with buttons down the front, padded sides?)

Maurice – Trousers and shirt

Old beggar woman/ Enchantress – Sparkly dress and dark cloak

Cogsworth – Brown outfit

Lumiere- Golden/orange outfit

Mrs Potts – Pastel colour dress with padded skirt

Babette – Black and white dress or top and skirt, black bow for hair

**Chip** – Pastel coloured outfit

Narrators and Singing Narrators – Bright sparkly outfit

Flatware- Golden outfit

Les Filles- Bright outfit, dress or skirt and top if possible
