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Bikeability Level 1 Cycle Control Skills

Course Location: St Chad's Patchway Primary School

Dates of Training: Tuesday 6th December 2022

Dear Parent/Guardian

A cycle control skills course is to be conducted at your child's school. It is designed to improve their cycling skills and is a pre-requisite to taking part in an on-road training course later on in Years 5/6. The course is delivered in the School and run by Bikeability accredited cycle instructors. Activities will involve a simple bike check, use of gears and brakes, slow riding, close control skills, riding with one hand, and balance exercises. As with other school activities, South Gloucestershire Council does not provide Personal Accident Insurance cover for children during training, and parents who want this type of cover should make their own arrangements.

Training Conditions

- 1. The course MUST be carried out on a mechanically sound bicycle adjusted to suit the rider. The bike will be checked at the start of the course and if any dangerous faults are found it will mean you child cannot continue with the training. Responsibility for ensuring a bike is roadworthy remains with the parent/guardian. In the current climate we ask that bicycles are checked prior to the course to minimise contact that our instructors need to have with the bicycle.
- 2. Whilst cycle helmets do not prevent accidents, they drastically reduce the risk of serious head injury if an accident occurs. Parents are, therefore required to supply a properly fitted and adjusted helmet to a recognised safety test standard, (e.g. BS EN 1078, SNELL CERTIFIED, ANSI Z 90.4). Again in the current climate we ask that the fit of the helmet is checked at home prior to the course to minimise contact with our instructors.
- Your child will be expected to behave in a safe and orderly manner complying with social distancing guidelines and failure to comply with this may mean your child will be excluded from the course.
- 4. If your child is not in school due to covid they will be unable to attend the bikeability lesson
- 5. Please return the completed consent form to your school. Failure to do so will result in the child not being accepted for either session.
